To celebrate Saint Patrick’s life, Ireland began commemorating him around the 9th or 10th century with religious services and feasts. St. Patrick’s Day parades, and other events that celebrated Irish heritage, became popular — and even drew the attention of political hopefuls looking to capture the Irish American vote. Since March 17 falls during the Lent — a Christian season that prohibits the consumption of meat, among other things — revelers would attend church services in the morning and celebrate the saint in the afternoon. In fact, coming is a way to preserve beef, and, while it dates back to the Middle Ages, the practice became popular amongst Irish immigrants living in New York City in the 1800s. The most famous? Did the Christian missionary really accomplish this feat? Contrary to popular belief, the first St. Patrick’s Day parade was thrown in North America in 1601. In the U.S., massive celebrations are held in major cities like Chicago, Boston, New York City, and Savannah. Each year, the holiday attracts about one million people to the country — and, in particular, to Dublin, which is home to Guinness, Ireland’s famous stout. In 1737, Irish folks in Boston held what some considered to be the city’s first St. Patrick’s Day parade — though it was more of a walk up Tremont Street, really. While he did escape, Saint Patrick is credited with returning to Ireland and bringing Christianity with him around 432 AD, which is likely why he’s been made the country’s national apostle. Now, parades are an integral part of the revelry, especially in the United States where millions of people flock to the over 100 parades held annually throughout the country.
